- ➤ The agreement was signed between Director General of Israel's National Cyber Directorate (NCD) and India's Ambassador to Israel Sanjeev Singhla.




Azad Pattern Hydel Power Project


Acharya Shree Purushottam Priyadasji Swamishree


Honorary Degree from University of Manchester
