COVAXIN

- ➤ The Drug Controller General of India has given approval for phase 1 and phase 2 human clinical trial for COVID-19 vaccine 'COVAXIN'.
- The vaccine is developed by Hyderabad based vaccine & bio-therapeutics manufacturer-Bharat Biotech in association with the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR).

Agreement for two project in Tamilnadu

- An agreement was signed between the World Bank Group and the Government of India for providing urban poor in the state of Tamilnadu access to affordable housing.
- ➤ The agreement signed has two projects under it 1) Tamilnadu Housing sector Strengthening program and 2) Tamilnadu Housing and and Habitat Development Project.

International

Hydroelectric Project

- India and Bhutan Signed a pact for the construction of the 600 Mw Kholongchhu joint venture hydroelectric project in Bhutan.
- ➤ This river project is located on the lower course of the Kholongchhu river in eastern Bhutan. The project will be completed in estimated 2025.
- Capital of Bhutan: Thimpu
- > Prime Minister of Bhutan: Lotay Tshering
- The currency of Bhutan: Bhutanese ngultrum.

New strain Swine Flu in China

- ➤ A new virus has been discovered by scientists In China that is quite similar to the 2009 Swine Flu that caused global pandemic. The new strain virus is named as 'G4 EA H1N1
- > It has human pandemic potential.
- The G4 virus can replicate in human cells and the test results have further shown that the immunity developed by a human body against seasonal flu won't be able to provide protection to the human body against this virus.
