- World Sickle Cell Awareness Day is observed on 19 June to raise the public awareness about sickle cell disease.
- ➤ It is a genetic disorder related to shortage of hemoglobin in blood.
- ➤ Sickle cell disorders are a group of illness which affects our red blood cells
- ➤ The United Nation General Assembly adopted a resolution to recognize sickle cell disease as a public health problem and "one of the world foremost's genetic diseases"

- ➤ International Day for the Elimination of Sexual Violence in conflict is observed globally on 19th June.
- This day is seen to stop Sexual Violence and to honour those who are victims and Survivors of Sexual Violence around the world.
- ➤ On 19 June 2015 United Nations General Assembly decided to observe 19 June as International Day for Elimination of sexual violence in conflict all over the world

- Chattisgarh government brings a new initiative named "Spandan" for armed and police Personnel.
- ➤ Through this initiative Police personnel are protected themselves from depression and stress

- ➤ Volkan Bozkir, a Turkish diplomat has been elected president of the 75th session of the UN General Assembly.
- ➤ The 75 session of UN General Assembly will begin on September 2020.

➤ Headquarter of UN General Assembly: New York, United States. Founded in 1945.

- ➤ Union Health Minister Harsh Vardhan has launched India's first mobile lab named The Infectious Disease Diag Lab (I-Lab).
- ➤ It has been developed with the help of Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology and Andhra Pradesh Med-Tech Zone.

➤ Karnataka Government observed the Mask Day on 18 June to aware the people about the use of masks, sanitizers, washing hands with soap in order to control the spread of COVID 19 in the state

- India will be UNSC President for August 2021.
- ➤ India secured 184 votes out of the 193 votes in a election of 5 Non permanent members in United Nations Security Coucil(UNSC) for two years.
- ➤ The post of presidency of UNSC is roated among the 15 members (Permanent-5 and Non- permanent- 10). Based on that India will get presidency of UNSC in the month of August 2021 and again for the month in the year 2022.

- > 5 Permanent members of UNSC are: USA, Russia, France, China and United Kingdom.
- ➤ 10 Non Permanent members are elected among the other members of United Nations. They are elected for 2 years
