Oxygen Management Committee

- **Oxygen Management Committee** has been formed to maintain the **supply of oxygen** to the **health institutions and hospitals**.
- **The State Secretary Kiran Gittee** become the secretary Chairman of the committee.
- **Joint Secretary Dr. Vishal Kumar** has been **convener** of the committee.

Rehabilitations of Bru

- The Central Government and the Tripura Government have undertaken RS. 1,200 crore ambitious project to rehabilitate 36,140 Bru migrants who fled from Mizoram to Tripura 24 years ago following ethnic Strife.
- Tripura Government has selected 13 locations in different districts to rehabilitate Bru migrants.
- Earlier the Central Government has already announced a RS 600 Crore package for the resettlement of these tribal migrants in Tripura.

General Secretary of Tripura Branch of Indian Red Cross Society

- Retired Indian Forest Service Officer Prasanjit Biswas has been elected as CEO and General Secretary of Tripura Branch of Indian Red Cross Society for a period of three years.

Oxygen Park

- The Tripura Government forest department build a new park to increase people's interest in natural greenery which named as 'Oxygen Park'.
- The government has designed the gate of the park as lungs.
- The park is situated in the dense area of shawl Bagan about 4 km from the main city of Agartala.

Organic outlets

- Tripura Agriculture Department has decided to open organic outlets in every districts to double the farmers' income.
- This attempt will facilitate the farmers who have responded to the call of the mission of organic.
- A total 200 hectare of cropland managed by four FPC (Former Producer Companies) in Tripura has been awarded the status of C3 Organic Certification as per the standards of India organic.
- The first outlet will be opened at Agartala horticulture directorate.

Educational TV Channel

- The education department of the state had decided to launch its own T.V channel to continue studies of students across the state at the COVID Pandemic situation.
- The name of the channel will be 'Vande Tripura'.

Obituary

- The Chief Architect of Central Public Works Department (CPWD) Tapas Devbarman who is from Tripura passed away due to COVID 19 at nursing home in Delhi.
- Tripura TRTC building and Sepahijala wooden resort were designed by him.

Post Devolution Revenue Deficit (PDRD) Grant

- The Union Finance Ministry on 6th May released the 2nd monthly installment of post Devolution Revenue Deficit (PDRD) Grant of RS 9,871 crore for the year 2021 – 22 to 17 states – Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamilnadu, Tripura Uttarakhand and West Bengal.
- RS 19, 742 crore has been released in the first two months of the current financial year as PDRD grant to the states.

- A total RS. 1, 18, 452 crore has been recommended as PDRD Grant by the Fifteenth Finance Commission for the financial year 2021 – 22. The grant will be released in 12 monthly installment.
- Under Article 275 of the Constitution, the central Government provides the grant to the 17 states.
- The chairman of the 15th Finance Commission :- Nand Kishore Singh (N.K Singh).

International Drawing and Painting Competition

- A class vii student of Holy Cross School Baibhav Datta has been awarded in International level for setting a record of attaining maximum number of certificates from various drawing and Painting competitions.
- He has been honoured by the Asia Book of records recognized by World Record university and International Protocol Record on 6th April, 2021 for his achievements in state, national and international levels.
- He received the highest number of certificates mementos and medals in the record of different Asian Countries like 'India Book of Records', 'Vietnam Book of Records', 'Asia Book of Records', Indonesian Professional Speakers' Association', 'Bangladesh Book of Records', .
- He has been awarded with a champions of painting certificate from Champions Book of World Records'. Moreover he has been awarded with Golden Peacock Award from Munushya Bal Vikas Lakseva Academy. He has also earned the 'Child Prodigy Award'.

- The Jampui hill Mizo Convention gave financial aid RS 1 lakh to the Myanmarrese refugees who had fled to Mizoram in the wake of Military takeover of the country.

Second Position of Vaccination

- Among the 28 states in India, Tripura achieved the second position in providing the first dose of 18 to 44 year old COVID 19 Vaccination.
- Tripura bagged the second position with 23.02% of vaccination while Sikkim grabbed the first position with 24.39% of vaccination.

Oxygen generation Plants

- In order to control the **second wave of Corona virus** in **North eastern states**, **The Government of Japan** and the **United Nation's organ the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP)** have partnered to **install oxygen generation plants** in **north eastern states** like **Meghalaya, Nagaland and Tripura**.
- The hospitals with a capacity of **approx 1,300 beds** have been identified in the region for the **oxygen generation** in the region.
- **Excess Oxygen** will be distributed among **other health institutions**.

Demand of Tripura Customary Law Bill 2019 into an act

- Four organizations of Tripura Samaj namely Tripura Samaj Narans, Tripura Ohubulai Buthu, Tripura Surangnai Buthu and Tripura Language Development Committee in a joint deputation to the Forest Minister Mewar kumar Jamatia demanded immediate step to convert the Tripura Customary Law Bill 2019 into an act.
- The bill was passed by the Tripura Tribal Areas Autonomous District Council on 16th October 2019.

'Jal Jeevan Mission'

- The Central Government has sanctioned an amount of RS 614 crore for Tripura for implementation of the Jal Jeevan Mission under Ministry of Jal Shakti.
- The first installment of RS 142 crore is registered with the state government's account in the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on 13 May.
- The total amount sanctioned for this year is almost four times higher than the fund sanctioned last year.
- The State Government will extend water supply connection to three lakh rural households.
- The state Government is determined to deliver supply water connection to all the people in the state by the end of the year 2022.

COVID War Room

- With special initiative of Viswashree B, District Magistrate of Sepahijala, for the first time a COVID War Room has been set up with sixty teacher. The teachers have been trained for this task.
- The War Room will function round the clock to deliver information regarding COVID Care Centers, ambulance, hospitals beds and medical shops in the district.

- The students from any part of the state have the opportunity to study in these schools.
- The curriculum is being conducted as per CBSE norms at present.
- The schools would have subject teachers for every subject, laboratories, libraries and sports ground.
- Each class would have maximum 40 students.
- In case of appointment of Headmaster/ Headmistress for these schools, the state Government would conduct a special selection test.

- The famous Linguist, Essayist, Book editor, specialist of Najrul arts and the editor of Gyan Bichitra Paper and publication **Dilip Chowdhury** passed away due to **COVID- 19**.

- The member of Tripura Cricket Association and the editor of Tripura Truck Owners Association Rupak Berman passed away due to COVID – 19.

'Corona Crisis Management Group'

- The Tripura Government has formed a 'Corona Crisis Management Group' to control COVID-19 situation in the state.
- The Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb became the head of the State level committee.
- The panel is set to deal with the situation from state level to the village level.
- The committee will deal with the state level to district level.
- Separate committees will be formed for ADC area, Agartala Municipal Corporation, each ward of AMC, urban local bodies, Panchayat Level to provide safety equipment and creating awareness about Coronavirus among people.

Export jackfruits

- The consignment of **350 jackfruits** were exported from **Tripura** to **United Kingdom** through **Guwahati** and **Delhi**.
- Earlier in **2019**, **Tripura** Successfully exported **Queen Pineapple** to **Dubai** and other parts of **middle east**.
- The state has **three varieties** of **pineapples** _ **Kew**, **Queen** and **Bombay**. Among them, **Queen Pineapples** are considered the **most exotic** and are in **great demand**.

- The former football striker from Tripura and the member of BSF Central Tapan Kumar Debnath passed away.

Paediatric Committee

- The State government has formed a 4 member Paediatric committee to control the infection of COVID 19 among the children of the state.

Biodiversity Management committee got awards

- On the day of **International Biological Diversity Day**, **Twichin Gram Bari Biodiversity Management Committee** of Tripura has been awarded by **Government of India** under '**Award Category V**' replicable mechanism of **ABS**.
- **Twichin Gram Bari Biodiversity Management committee**, Tripura has successfully integrated accessed and beneficiaries provisions of **biological diversity** in **2002** with the working of **Joint Forest Management Committee**.
- It helped the generation of **additional incomes** of over **RS 5000 per month** for **over 250 families** by providing **natural resources**.

“One Stop Centres’

- Among 701 ‘One Stop Centres in the country’ eight centres are located in Tripura.
- This ‘One Stop Centres is centrally sponsored Scheme under Ministry of Women and Child Development (MWCD).
- Such kind initiative had been taken to remove the violence against women. It was established to provide integrated support and assistance under one roof to women affected by violence both in Private and public spaces.
- The scheme is funded through Nirbhaya Fund and the Central Government provides 100% financial assistance to the state Government and Union Territories administration.

Tea from Bamboo leaves

- After producing **rice** and **cookies** from **Bamboo**, now **tea** has been made from **bamboo leaves** in the **state**. **Samir Jamatia** from **Agartala** has made **tea** with **bamboo leaves**.
- The tea made from bamboo leaves has been used in **China** since **ancient times**.
- There are various **medicinal properties** in that tea
 - 1) This kind of bamboo tea has many **beneficial properties** in **protecting hair, skin and teeth** and helping to **strengthen bones and teeth**.
 - 2) The **colour** of the tea is **red** and the **taste** is the same as **ordinary tea**.
- Such kind of tea are made of **T. O liveri bamboo** and **Kanack Kaich bamboo leaves**. However this kind of tea can be made by **all kind of bamboo's leaves**.

Paid COVID Care Centre

- The west Tripura District administration has declared Ginger hotel at Agartala as state's first Paid COVID Care Centre for the patients who want to access paid medical services.
- All the healthcare services will be delivered by Divine Touch mediclinic authorities, a private healthcare service.

e – Sanjivani OPD Portal

- The state government started tele consultation programme through 'e- Sanjivani OPD Portal' for those COVID infected Patients who are in home isolation.
- The Medical officers under the guidance of Dr. Nilanjan Bhattacharjee , State Program officer will direct tele- consultation to the COVID – 19 patients under home isolation. They are also being allowed to prescribe basic medicines as per the guideline for COVID 19 home isolation. For additional support they may refer the patients to the nearest health facility.
- Home isolation patients could register their names on the website "www.esanjavevanipd.in "

20,000 metric ton paddy from farmers

- The state council Minister has decided to buy 20,000 metric ton paddy from farmers at the rate of Rs 18.68 per kg to double the farmers' income.
- Farmers will get 37.36 crore.

Webapp

- A group of Professionals and University students have launched at their own initiative a webapp to help the people during the COVID pandemic at Agartala.
- The Webapp is titled as 'bit.ly/agt COVIDhelp'
- It contains all the details of the COVID service being provided by government run hospitals and health centres and also by Private hospitals.
- People can get all the information and even physical help at need by logging to this app.

Chief Resident Commissioner, Tripura Bhavan , New Delhi

- Dr. G.S.G Ayyangar , IAS posted as Chief Resident Commissioner, Tripura Bhavan, New Delhi on repatriation from Central Deputatation. He was posted as Senior Deputy Director General, Indian council of Medical Research under the department of Health Research.

New CEO of TTAADC

- Shri Abhishek chandra, IAS became the new CEO (Chief Executive Officer) of TTAADDC .

Upgradation of ADC Hospital

- The State Government has decided to sanction RS 30 crore to upgrade the hospital infrastructure in the tribal dominated areas of the state's Autonomous District Council (ADC) amid the outbreak of deadly coronavirus.

150 LPM Oxygen generation plant

- The chief Minister of Tripura laid the foundation of 150 LPM Oxygen generation plant at Kherengbar Community Health Centre in ADC headquarter, Khumulwng on 26 May.
- The government has decided to announce a financial package of RS 579 crore to tackle the Corona Pandemic in the state.

Bamboo utensil

- After **Bamboo leaf tea**, **Samir Jamatia** from Agartala Joined a project which is in Collaboration with **Central Institute of Petrachemical Engineering and Technology (CIPET)** to make **various utensils** from Bamboo.

Administrative Reforms

- The State Government have undertaken various administrative reforms under the initiative of the urban development department of the state for the benefit of the citizens of 20 urban local bodies of the state through Ease of Doing Business.
- The Service includes issuance of online building plan, payment of property tax, issuance of trade licence, approval of hoardings or signage,
- For this the general public can now apply online from home by visiting the nearest common Service centre.
- The People can get various facilities and certificates in online within the stipulated time.

The Light House Project

- The Light House Project of Agartala which was started in March is expected to complete by the end of June of next year 2022.
- Light House Project is one of the six such projects under the Global Housing Technology Challenges – India (GHTC – India) initiative taken by Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Government of India.
- The Project was inaugurated by the Prime Minister on 1st Jan 2021.

Legal Advisors for eight districts

- The state Government on 12th May has decided to appoint altogether nine legal advisors for eight districts including crime branch in the capital and one more the police headquarter.
- The advisors will help, guide and assist the police in matter of filing charge-sheets in court proceedings and legal matters specially in case of heinous crimes like murder, rape, economic offences and corruption cases.
- The applicants must have five years experience in conducting criminal cases in judicial magistrate court as well as in sessions Court.
- The retired law officers of any state or central government department will also be considered eligible for this posts.
- The conduct of appointment will be for one year but may be renewed On the basis of performance.

Ex-situ breeding programme

- Tripura Forest Department has initiated a special ex-situ breeding programme for clouded leopards which is IUCN listed endangered species of wild cats found in the forest of Tripura.
- Spectacles monkeys and pig-tailed macaque have also been included in the special ex-situ conservation drive.
- Apart from that elephant, Bison, vulture and Hornbill camp will be set up at Teliamura.

Tripura Government

The chief Minister of Tripura Biplab Kumar Deb announced a Scheme “Mukhyamantri Valya Seva Prakalpa for those children of the state who lost their parents due to COVID 19 pandemic.

However the government is not having any data of children in Tripura who had become orphans by losing their parents due to COVID 19. But the Government will start their survey soon.

The assistance will be provided for

- 1) For those children who want to live with their relatives
- 2) For those children who want to live in Child's home
- 3) For Girls

The Children who want to live with their relatives

The children who lost their parents in Corona Pandemic and are going to live with their relatives, The State government with their scheme will provide them an amount of RS 3,500 per month till 18 years of age and The State Government will bear all the expenditure of their education.

The children who want to live in Child's home

The children who lost their parents due to Corona virus pandemic and are going to live in **Child's home, The State Government** with their scheme will bear **all financial expenditures.**

For Girl's Children

For a **Girl's Child** the **State Government** will provide **financial assistance of RS 50,000** for **her marriage** after the **competition of education**. Moreover **laptop and as well as tablet** will be provided to them after **qualifying Class X board Examination**.

Largest Oxygen plant

- The largest oxygen plant in North East region is going to be set up at IGM Hospital in Agartala which will produce 1500 litres of oxygen in liquid form per minute.
- The Present plant in Govinda Ballav Pant Hospital produces 900 litres of oxygen in liquid form.
- It is decided to set up more than 18 oxygen plants in eight districts by National Health Mission.

Fund for MGNREGA

- Tripura Government has decided to announce RS 579 crore for generating MGNREGA work, Tripura Urban Employment Programme (TUEP) and to help poor people financially amid the Corona Pandemic.

Tripura's cricketer in England

- The cricketer of our state and incumbent captain of Tripura Cricket team Manishankar Murasingh will play for Tod Modern club of the Lancashire country, England
- This is higher level of country cricket dominated by English players and from other countries.
