
Rs 78.90 crore raised through Special Window in Tripura


- The famous scientist of the state Kshitish Chandra Majumder passed away. He was from Belonia.

Case of anemia has been increased in Tripura, released in 5th national Family Health Survey

- The Prevalence of anemia was found to have increased in the state Tripura among Children and adults in comparison to 2015-16 survey report to 1st Phase of 5th report of National Family Health Survey (NFHS) released in this year.
- The report was made based on the survey conducted by the Indian Institute of Health Management Research (IIHMR).
- In case of Tripura 64.03% children aged between 6 to 59 months have been found anemia in comparison to 48.03% in 2015-16 survey report.
- The Union Health Minister Dr. Harsh Vardhan released the 5th National Family Health Survey.

Alcohol consumption in Tripura revealed in National Family Health Survey report

- At the 1st phase of 5th report of National family Health Survey (NFHS), it is said that people from rural areas of Tripura are more addicted to alcohol consumption if compared to urban areas of the state.
- 26.9 percent of the urban male consume alcohol in above the age of 15 years. Similarly, the percentage of rural male in same age group at 35.9 Percent. The total average of rural and urban areas stands at 33.1 percent.
- The percentage of rural men using tobacco stands at 59.3 percent whereas in urban areas it is in 51.6 percent and the average of using of tobacco in rural and urban areas is 56.9 percent.

- In the case of the women, women in urban areas who are exposed to alcohol consumption is 0.8 percent whereas among the rural women, the percentage is 8.4 percent and the average of both the figures stands at 6.2 percent.
- The urban women who are addicted to any kind of tobacco stands at 46.1 percent and in rural areas is 52.2 percent and the average of using tobacco by women in rural and urban areas is50.4 percent.

- The High Court of Tripura has canceled the OBC reservation in three seats in Regional Institute of Medical Sciences (RIMS) for medical admissions in Tripura.
- However the court announced in fervour of 10 reservations for the financially weaker sections at Agartala Government Medical College.
- Public Prosecutor Debalaya Bhattacharya, a division bench of Tripura High Court headed by chief Justice Akhil Kureshi and Justice SG Chattopadhyay passed the order.

Perishable fish items through Khowaighat and Manu Land Custom Station

On 17th December 2020, The Centre has allowed import of perishable fish items through Khowaighat and Manu Land custom station.

Urban bodies election deferred

- The election of 21 urban bodies of Tripura including Agartala Municipal Corporation have been deferred and since election could not be held in time.
- In case of Agartala Municipal Corporation, District Magistrate of West Tripura would take charge as administrator.
- On the other hand other Municipal boards and Nagar Panchayat, local SDMs would take charge the duty of administrator.

Homeopathic drug 'Arsenicum Album-30

Following the advice of the Union AYUSH (Ayurveda Yoga and Naturapathry, Unani, Siddha Homeapathy) Ministry, the State's Directorate of Health Service, Tripura Government has started distribution of a homeapathic drug 'Arsenicum Album – 30 to boost immunity of the people against coronavirus.

Six projects for South Tripura

- An amount of RS 573.99 crore has been sanctioned for six projects to be implemented in South Tripura.
- Among them RS 118.47 crore has been estimated for creating a Logistics Hub at Sabroom and the estimated cost for Integrated check post is RS 97.60 crore. Besides the Multipurpose Economic Zone will be set up on a 16.35 hectare area at a total cost of RS 60.57 crore and a road infrastructure project – 22 km national highway (NH 108) from Jolaibari to Belonia at a cost of RS 201.99 crore.





The Government of Tripura signed an agreement with ADB

- The Government of Tripura has signed a loan agreement with the Asian Development Bank for development of urban areas and Tourism sector in Tripura.
- The Resident Commissioner of Tripura Shri Chitanya Murti, IFS signed the loan Negotiation documents of Project Readiness Finance PRF with Mr. Takeo Kanishi, country Director, ADB in presence of DR. CS Mahapatra, Additional Secretary Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance.
- Under the loan agreement, ADB shall provide 40 crores for engagement of Project Design and Management Consultants for Urban and Tourism Sectors. 20 urban bodies in Tripura will be covered under this project.
- Once the project are prepared, ADB will provide 1600-crores for development works in Urban areas and 500 crores in tourism sector over next three years.





A song Composed by the Deputy Chief Minister of Tripura

- The Deputy Chief Minister of Tripura Jishnu Dev Verma who is known for his all round intellectually and passion for art and music wrote a song 'Omo No Ani Imang' (That is my Dream) was officially released in Sukanta Academy.

Charilam Higher Secondary School has been declared itself 100 % free Plastic free school.



Chief Administrative Cum Accountants Officers

- Chief Administrative Cum Accountants Officers were appointed for Seven Districts Courts except Khowai.
- Krishna Das Chakraborty was appointed as Administrative of West Tripura District Court. On the other hand, Sankar Das in Gomati District Court, Amiya Sinku Das in Sepahijala District Court, Shubaha Chakma in Unakoti District Court, Udayan Chakma in South Tripura District Court, Dhananjay Jamatia in Dhalai District and Sudhangshu Malakar in North Tripura District were appointed as Administrative of the related District Court.
- Such post was created in 2014 following the instruction of Shethi Commission. Earlier the post was reserved only for West Tripura District court, Later it was expanded.

Tripura's veterinarian found a way to get pigs foods from rubber seeds

- The reputed veterinarian of the State Dr. Diptanu Das found a way to get higher yield of a lower cost by feeding pigs mixed with uncoventional rubber seeds powder instead of marketed food.
- He carried out research on the matter under supervision of DR AK Samanta of the Department of Animal Nutrition, College of Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry, Mizoram.





Health Insurance Scheme for media people

- At the first State Conference of Forum for Development and Protection of Media Community (FPDMC), The Chief Minister of Tripura Biplab Kumar Deb on 20th December has announced that Health Insurance Scheme for media people along with several other facilities.

- Moreover the Chief Minister also announced to deliver 300 more press jeckets to media personnel.







- Remote areas of Tripura such as Magroom, Karbook, Silachari, Shuknaichari, Thalcherra and so on will be connected with mobile phone towers.

State's first hospital introduced Paediatric surgery

- Tripura Medical College (TMC) at Hapania and Dr. BRAM Teaching Hospital has now started Paediatric surgery at lower cost.

- On 23rd December 2020 in the state cabinet meeting, The State Government of Tripura announced a new Scheme 'Mukhyamantri Matriphshti Uphar' to improve the nutritional Support for pregnant women before their delivery.
- Under this new scheme, the special kit consisting of 250 gms of ground nut, 300 gms of roasted Bengal gram, 180 gms of Soyabean, 500 gms of mixed dal, 500 gms of jiggery, 200 ml of ghee, 200 gms of cashew nut and 100 gms of raisins will be provided to pregnant women after fourth times checkup.

- The Social Welfare and Social Education Department has taken all responsibilities of this scheme and collected two authorized state cooperative namely "Tripura MarkFed" and "Aitorma Cooperative department stores" for supplying Special nutritional kit to pregnant mother through out the state.
- "Tripura MarkFed is entrusted with supply of kits to meet the requirement of the 1st three months for January, February and March.



- According to expert the new strains of Coronavirus is 70% more infectious than other strains of virus.

- It is estimated that the new MBB airport will be inaugurated on 31st March 2021.

Women Sex Ratio, electricity connectivity, Access to developed lavatory has been improved in Tripura

- According to 5th report of National Family Health Survey released by the Union Health Minister Harsh Vardhan, Women Sex ratio in Tripura has been improved. Women Sex ratio which was 998 women per 1000 men in the year 2015-16 but in recent time in 2019-20 the ratio has been improved to 1,011 women per 1000 men.
- In the matter of electricity connectivity, in 2015-16, electricity connectivity was available for 92.8 percent families where as new the figure has been improved to 98.2 percent families in 2019-20.

- Access to developed lavatory was available for 63.7 percent families in the year 2015-16 and now it stood at 73.7 percent families in 2019-20.
- Moreover the facilities of drinking water has improved in Tripura.





Job due to Political Violence

- As per decision taken from Six member team, the State Government of Tripura decided to provide Government job to those families that are suffered due to political violence or attacks till 9th March 2018.
- Moreover inquiry will also be done by the DM and SP level officers. A family can procure form from the SDM office if it has any such case.

- A total of 15 riders would cover 20,000 km in 29 states and 5 Union territories.

- The road map of this Yatra would start from Agartala and end at the same place covering 45 places.
- During the yatra, a total of 50 thousand saplings will be planted in all states with sacred soil and water of Maa Tripureswari. On the other hand Soil and Water will be collected from different parts of the country.

Using Internet in Tripura NFHS - 5

- At the fifth report of National Family Health Survey 2019-20, it is said that only 22.9 percent female population who have ever used internet in which 17.7 Percent female population in rural areas and 36.6 percent of female population in Urban areas use internet.
- On the other hand, 45.7 Percent male population in Tripura use internet in which 45.2 percent male population in rural areas and 47.0 percent male population in urban areas use internet.





Literacy rate in Tripura NFHS - 5

- According to 5th report of National Family Health Survey 2019-20, Tripura is holding a good position in the matter of literacy in the country.
- The literacy rate in the state for men is 88.2 percent while the women literacy rate stands 80.6 percent.
- Total literacy rate in rural areas 76.9 percent and 89.9 percent in urban areas.

HIV/AIDS report in Tripura NFHS - 5

- The Government of Tripura has set target to make Tripura free of HIV/AIDS by 2030.
- In a 5th report of National Family Health Survey 2019-20 it is found that only 15.4 percent female have comprehensive knowledge on HIV/AIDS in which 19.7 percent female in urban areas and 13.7 percent female in rural areas have knowledge on HIV/AIDS.
- Only 30 percent male have knowledge on HIV/AIDS in which 40.6 percent in urban areas and 25.6 percent in rural areas have knowledge about HIV/AIDS.





Continue

- The statistic released by Tripura State AIDS Control Society on 1st December has shown that total no. of HIV/AIDS positive persons in Tripura from 1916 to October 2020 – 690 female and 1226 male.
- North District of Tripura holds highest record with 530 HIV/AIDS cases while West Tripura is in second position with 397 cases. Moreover Unakoti and Khowai are in Third and fourth position in HIV/AIDS cases.
- > 10 people from outside Tripura are infected by HIV virus.

Infant and Child Mortality rate in Tripura/ NFHS - 5

- According to 5th report of National Family Health Survey 2019-20, there was a sharp increase in Infant and Child Mortality rate (Per 1000 birth). However there is increase in institutional Delivery from 79.9 percent in 2015-16 to 89.2 percent in 2019-20.
- The Neonatal mortality rate in 2015-16 was only 13.2 percent and now it is increased to 22.9 percent in 2019-20.
- Similarly the state recorded an increase in infant mortality rate from 26.7 percent in 2015-16 to 37.6 percent in 2019-20.





- The report also shows that under five mortality rate (U5MR) has also risen from 32.7 percent in 2015-16 to 43.3 percent in 2019-20.
- The infant and child mortality rate is the number of deaths of children under one year of age per 1000 live births.

Marriage and Fertility rate in Tripura/NFHS - 5


- In the 5th report of National Family Health Survey 2019 – 20 it is shown that the women who were married before 18 years had gone up from 33.1 percent in 2015-16 to 40.1 percent in 2019-20.
- The figure in case of men who married before 21 years had also increased from 16.2 percent in 2015-16 to 20.4 percent in 2019 – 20.

- This project is taken to solve the troubles permanently for people residing along Haora river bank area from flood.



Cochlear Implant

- This is the first time in Tripura, one three-and-half-year old kid from Khowai Pushpita Pal has undergone successful Cochlear implant at GBP Hospital at free of cost.
- Pushpita was deaf since birth and She was also unable to speak due to her deafness.
- The Government of India supplied this device of worth RS. 5.5 lakh free of cost.
- Dr. Amitabh Roy Choudhury came to GBP Hospital as a mentor for this operation.





Obituary

- The former Army Subedar Niprendra Chandra Dey, resident of Bamutia passed away on 28th December, 2020.
- He was awarded by the President of India for his bravery.
- He took part in 1965 Indo China War and 1971 Indo-Pak War.
- He was also an efficient football player.



Waive Stamp Duty

- The State Cabinet has decided to waive stamp duty on loans upto Rs 5 lakh from banks for various government – sponsored projects such as Kisan Credit Card, PM Kisan, Self Help Group (SHG), Prime Minister's Employment Generation Program, Swabalamban, Prime Minister's Street Vendor Self – Reliance Fund, Prime Minister's Housing Scheme, Chief Minister's B.Ed Inspiration.
- The decision was taken with the aim of building a self-reliant Tripura and The State Government is going to loss about 60.90 lakh in a year.



New Appointment Policy

- In a state cabinet meeting, it has been decided to add a new amendment to the new appointment policy in government offices.
- According to new amendment in appointment policy, from now the job seeker would require to have knowledge in Bengali or Kokborok language as well as the required qualification.

Drum Seeder Machine in subsidized prices

- The State Government of Tripura has decided to introduce drum seeder machines in subsidized prices for the farmers of Tripura.
- This initiative was taken in order to reach the goal of doubling the income of farmers and also to cut short initial investment to the farmers.
- This machine helps farmers to sow greater stretch of land in limited time enabling the farmer to fetch less time consuming results.





Continue

- The state government of Tripura has granted subsidy of RS 4000 for each of the 50 drum seeders that will be introduced in various parts of Tripura within this year.
- First, this machine is being introduced in "Bagaba agri-subdivision".

32nd Eastern Athletics Competition

- Tripura got 13 medals along with three gold medals at "32nd Eastern Junior Athletics Competition" held in Guwahati.
- From Tripura Pratima Sarkar, Sushmita Debbarma and Paliromi Malik won gold medals.





The State Level tri-monthly fourth stage of Active Case to eradicate TB disease

- The State Level tri-monthly fourth stage of Active Case has been started from 18th December to eradicate TB disease.
- This TB control programme will continue up to 31st December, 2020.
- Under this program cough of suspected persons will be collected from door to door.
- In the campaign medical staff and ASHA workers will interact with local people in TB disease prone areas of every districts.

- 1) From now Verbal FIR along FIR must be recorded and action should be taken immediately after lodging FIR.
- Police need to frame time limits for delivery of various types of services to the public and to ensure the services are delivered to the people in a time – bound manner.

- 3) Police need to devise an effective public grievance redressal mechanism.
- 4) Internet facilities may provided to each police station to facilitate the works in an easy manner.
- 5) The appropriate authority should impart proper training to the police personnel to make them people friendly conduct them to obey the law strictly.





Priority in Maize and Mashkalai Cultivations

- Taking inspiration from Prime Minister Narendra Modi vision of doubling farmers' income by 2020, the state government has initiated a paradigm shift in Agriculture policy.
