- The purpose of launching of this software to provide all Government services to the doorstep of the people and to make various services of the Government easier and reach out to the people and to bring more transparency in the services of Government.

A rare butterfly discovered in Tripura

- A rare butterfly 'Red Imperial butterfly' or *susa lides* has been discovered by a guest lecturer of Zoology in Ramkrishna Mahavidyalaya of Kailasahar sub-division Nichar Chandra Deb during a field study in the Unakoti hill situated in Kailasahar sub-division of Unakoti District.
- The butterfly belongs to Imperial group and generally it has been found in semi-evergreen forest with hilly area like Manipur, Meghalaya, Assam and Arunachal Pradesh.

India's High Commissioner Visited to Tripura

- The new High Commissioner of India to Bangladesh **Vikram Doraiswami** visited **Tripura** enroute to **Bangladesh** to enquire the site of **Nischintapur Yard** under **Badharghat Assembly** where **construction of rail link between Agartala Railway Station and Akhaura Railway Station (Bangladesh)** is going on.
- He also visited **Belonia** to enquire **Muhurighat Land Custom Station** and Moreover He inspected **international border** along the **Muhuri river** with the local **MLA Arun Chandra Bhowmik**.

Tripura launched new rice made of bamboo

- **Tripura** has brought new type **rice** made of **bamboo** in the market.
- The **new type of bamboo rice** has been deprived from **the flowers blossom** in **bamboo**. The new rice is more effective for **health conscious people**. It is rich in **protein** and **good nutrition**.
- According to **clinical status** this **particular rice** is very useful to make strong our **immune system**.



Astrophotography apparatus installed

- In a new development in the field of Astrophysics, Tripura Astronomical Society has installed the first ever astrophotography apparatus at Tripura Astronomical Society situated at Udaipur.
- Tripura Astronomical Society, Udaipur is a science club affiliated with Vigyan Prasar under the Ministry of Science. The society is run by 27 members and more than 100 students are involved into it.
- According to a key member of Tripura Astronomical Society Ayan Saha the new apparatus can generate very good and well defined photographs about the movement of the earth clearly and the photograph can be captured through high resolution lenses which illustrate celestial bodies.

Tripura to protect the endangered Clouded Leopard

- Three northeastern states – Tripura, Meghalaya and Mizoram have taken a new step to protect the endangered clouded Leopard which is listed as vulnerable by the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) list.
- Clouded Leopard is found in the eastern Himalayas, the Assam Valley and the hill south of the Brahmaputra and Mizoram's Dampa Tiger Reserve has the highest number of Clouded Leopard in Southeast Asia.
- The density of population of clouded Leopards is known as "Kelral" is 5.14 per 100 sq km in the reserved areas situated along Mizoram, Bangladesh and Tripura.

- Moreover **Indian Government** has taken a lot of **step** to **conserve** this **endangered species**.
- Recently **Indian Olympics Association** decides to select **Meghalaya state's animal Clouded Leopard** as a **mascot** of **39 National Games 2023** in **Meghalaya**.



Green Newspaper Award 2020

- The well-known English Newspaper of Tripura 'The Tripura Times' has been chosen for the First Green Newspaper Award 2020 by Tripura Biodiversity Board. The Tripura Times got this award for its news, reports articles, news stories and their approach and contribution to generating awareness for preservation of environment, diversity, ecology, forest, wild-life etc.
- The award was given by Honorable Minister, Forest of our state Government Shri Mevar Kumar Jamatia in a function on 8th October at Heritage Park on the occasion of closing ceremony of wildlife week 2020.

- Tripura Bio Diversity Board announced this award for the first time this year to encourage and inspire media and media personnel for the course.

Mask Enforcement Day

- The Tripura Government decided to observe 'Mask Enforcement Day' on every Saturday of October in the state to alleviate the spread of COVID 19 in our state.
- Moreover Mask Enforcement Day was observed on 18th and 19th September in the State to raise awareness among people about the danger of COVID- 19.



Tripura Forest Department launches mobile application

- **Tripura Forest Department** has decided to launch **mobile application** that will allow the local public to report any violation at the wildlife and forest laws in real time so that Protection of wildlife and conservation of forest can be maintained from the ground level.
- The application is designed in such way that **rapid response team** can be pressed into action immediately.
- The Forest Minister of Tripura Government: **Shri Mevar Kumar Jamatia**.

Award of Green Reporter

- Journalist **Sudip Chandra Nath** has achieved the **award of Green reporter**.
- The award was given by **Tripura Forest Department** on the occasion of **wildlife week 2020** at **Heritage park** on **8th October**.
- Moreover The well-known English newspaper' **The Tripura Times'** has won the **First Green Newspaper award 2020**.

The State Government appointed Private Secretary to the CM

- The State Government of Tripura has appointed Jitendra Kumar Sinha, IAS as principal Secretary to the Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Dev with additional charge of health and family welfare department and finance department.

Nut Gardening Project

- **Nut gardening project** has been implemented for **120 Reang families** in **six remotes Reang villages** under **Ampi nagar RD block** in **Gomati District** by **TRP and PTG Department of Ampi nagar branch** in the **financial year 2020-2021**.



The Bangladesh High Commissioner to India visited Tripura

- The Bangladesh envoy to India **Muhammad Imran** along with his spouse and the first secretary of the Bangladesh High Commissioner from New Delhi Visited Tripura from 12th October to 15th October to inspect the ongoing bilateral projects in Tripura- Bangladesh border.
- They met Tripura's Governor Ramesh Kumar Bais and the Chief Minister of Tripura Biplab Kumar Deb.
- Moreover they visited several places of Tripura where various bilateral projects between two countries are going on. The places are Srimantapur Integrated Check Post and Sonamura port, Muhurighat Land Custom Station (LSS) and Muhuri Char, Beloina, Feni Bridge, Special Economic Zone (SEZ) and Akhaura- Agartala ongoing rail construction project.

- They also visited **Udaipur's Matabari temple.**
- Earlier on **4th October** the Indian High Commissioner to Bangladesh **Vikram Doraiswami** visited **Tripura** for **two days.**
- He visited ongoing construction sites like **Nischintapur Yard Sabroom Project site** and **Belonia land custom station.**

- The Chief Minister of Tripura Biplab Kumar Deb inaugurated the Jamjuri Adarsh Gram Abhiyan Project of Jamjuri Gram Panchayat in Kakraban R.D Block as a part of the Chief Minister's 'Adarsh Gram Abhiyan'.
- The Minister of Agriculture and Farmer's welfare Pranajit Singh Roy, MLA Ramapada Jamatia, Biplab Kumar Ghosh were present at inaugural Ceremony.
- The various opportunities like health, education, clean drinking water and electrification implemented in this village under this project.

Tripura got permission to raise additional amount through open Market borrowings

- The department of expenditure under the Ministry of Finance on 13th October granted permission to Tripura to raise an additional amount of RS 297 crore through open Market Borrowings.
- The Central Government in the meeting of GST Council held on 27th August, 2020 gave permission 20 states to raise total additional amount of 68, 825 crore through open market borrowings.
- Apart from Tripura, the other States which got permission to raise additional amount through Open Marketing are Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam Bihar, Goa Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Odisha, Sikkim, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand.

The number of Vulture of population increases in Tripura

- Sub Divisional Forest Officer of Khowai Niraj Kumar Chanchal stated that the number of vulture population are increasing in Tripura.
- This bird is included in critically endangered species in IUCN list.



Inclusion of new areas in different urban bodies

- The state Council of Ministers on 13th October decided to include new areas in 10 urban bodies under Tripura Municipal Act 1994.
- The 10 Urban local bodies are-
 - ✓ Agartala Municipal Corporation
 - ✓ Ranirbazar Municipal Council
 - ✓ Mohanpur Municipal Council,
 - ✓ Bishalgarh Municipal Council
 - ✓ Melagarh Municipal Council

The family pension of all labourers in Tripura are increased

- On 13th October The state council of Ministers in a meeting decided to increase the family pension of all labourers in Tripura from minimum of RS 300 and maximum of RS 600 to minimum of RS 1200 and maximum of RS 1800 per month.
- Around 1200 permanent labourers are in five different Government department like Agriculture and Farmer welfare, Animal Resource Development, Industries and Commerce, Fisheries and Forest Department.

Antigen Test

- The Health and Family Welfare department of Tripura Government started three days long 'Antigen' test drive from 15th October to 17th October 2020.
- A total of 30 clusters have been indentified across Tripura comprised of mixed corporation, Municipal Council, Nagar Panchayats and even blocks.
- Antigen test is a rapid diagnostic test suitable for point of care testing that directly detects the presence or absence of an antigen.

Tripura's short film secured in final top 30 in the Global Network Film Festival in UK.

- Tripura's short film "Sheetghoom Dream on the bed of Lies" has secured its position in final top – 30 films in the list – off Global Network Film Festival in UK based on global viewers, voting and jury scores.
- The film is based on the issues of social stigmas faced by the LGBTQ community and what happens to their lives .
- This short film earned worldwide appreciation and got rating of 6.2. The film is directed by Siddhartha Sankar Deb, Scripted by Vineet Nadnwana, Produced by Somualya Sankar Choudhry and the film is made by Siddhartha's Kalpadruma Production House.

- Two more short films of Siddhartha named 'Godhuli' and 'Yellow Stain' are also in the queue of competition. The short film "Godhuli" is about several issues of teenagers and how they shift their lives in wrong turn and the film "Yellow Stain" talked about mental health issue.
- Moreover the production house of Siddhartha Sankar Deb designed an another film 'El Amado' based on Rabindranath Tagore's unending love.

50,000 families will get benefits in PMAY

- 50,000 families in Tripura will get benefit of Pucca houses under the “Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana”
The decision was taken by the Union Ministry of Rural Development.
- Earlier the government of Tripura on May 2018 requested to the Union Ministry of Rural Development to approve Pucca houses under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana.



Disputed area between Tripura and Mizoram

- A tension was emerged between Tripura and Mizoram in the issue of construction of Shiva temple in Phuldungsei village .
- on 19th September and 20th September an organisation called 'Songrangama' in Tripura has planned to build a shiva temple at Thaidawr Tlang in Phuldungsei Village near Tripura and Mizoram border. But the construction was protested by Mizoram administration.
- on 16th October, 2020, the District Magistrate of Mamit district of Mizoram has issued section 144 in the disputed area.



Continue

- **No action** has been taken so far from **Tripura's administration**. However they are thinking any positive way to maintain law and order around the dispute area and solve the problem of two states in peaceful way.

New Secretary of Finance Department

- Apurba Roy, the secretary of planning and coordination has been appointed as the new secretary of Finance Department.
- He replaced Tanusree Debbarma.

Dasarath Dev State Sports Complex has been upgraded

- The Union Sports ministry has decided to upgrade Dasarath Dev Sports complex of Agartala to the Khelo India State Centre of Excellence (KISCE) under Khelo India Scheme.

Awards at 59th Teachers' Day Celebration

- On the occasion of 59th Teacher's Day celebration at the State Level Programme on 18th October, three colleges' Principal received honours .
- Among them Manideepa Debbarma, Principal of Women's College in Agartala and Biswajit Gupta, Acting Principal of Ramthakur college received honours for their personal contribution towards Higher Education.
- They received the honours from the Director of Higher Education Saju Vaheed, an IAS and Education Minister Ratan Lal Nath respectively.

- Another Higher Education Institution **Rabindranath Thakur college** in **Bishalgarh** achieved 'B' Grade accredited by **NAAC** for acquiring **good results** in **various fields**.
- **The Principal in charge** of **Rabindranath Thakur College** received the **honour**.

High-tech traffic interceptor Vehicles

- In order to ensure road safety for the citizens of the state and to curb road accidents and traffic violations, The Tripura Police launched high-tech traffic interceptor vehicles on 19th October, 2020.
- The Chief Minister of Tripura Biplab Kumar Deb flagged off the vehicles from his government residence.
- The vehicles will be deployed to the accident prone zone and highways of the state and it will be stationed at various locations where speed limits have been set.

- Moreover there is a **computer system** in **this vehicle** which can record **crime details** and **first-aid kit** are also **present** in the **vehicles**.



Bamboo Processing Unit

- on 19th October 2020, The Department of Industry and Commerce took initiatives to set up 28 bamboo processing units in eight districts of Tripura .
- A total of 850 bamboo artisans will find tall kits and 500 bamboo growers will receive cutters and splinters from Tripura Bamboo Mission in 2020-21 fiscal year.
- A meeting organised at the conference hall of the secretariat, The Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb along with chief secretary Manoj Kumar, Secretary of Industry and Commerce Department Kiran Gittee, Secretary of Rural Development Department Somuya Gupta, Mission Director of Tripura Bamboo Mission Prashant Kumar Goyal, Chief conservator of Forests D.K sharma reviewed the various programme under Tripura Bamboo Mission.

Continue

- Tripura Bamboo Mission is coordinated with Forest Department, Rural Development Department, JICA Handicrafts and Handicrafts Department, Tripura Forest Development and Plantation Corporation Limited and Tripura Rehabilitation.
- Moreover there are currently 21 species of bamboo in Tripura.



Substantial decline in worm infections in Tripura

- On 20th October 2020, The Health Ministry stated that Tripura has shown a 'substantial decline in worm infections' prevalent among children since the launch of the 'National Deworming Day' in 2015.
- Tripura is one of the nine states that have shown the substantial decline reduction in worm infections.
- Apart from Tripura, Chattisgarh, Himachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Sikkim, Telengana, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Bihar have shown Substantial reduction in worm infections.

Continue

- The National Deworming Day organized by World Health Organization (WHO) is meant to eliminate worm infections among children and adolescents.

Business Incubation Centre in Tripura University

- **Tripura University** has been selected to set up a **business incubation centre** that would promote new ideas of **self reliance**.
- This centre is going to become **the first of its kind** where **incubates** will be mentored for **commercial viability** and lab to **market mechanism**.
- The business incubator will be funded by the **Ministry of MSME**.

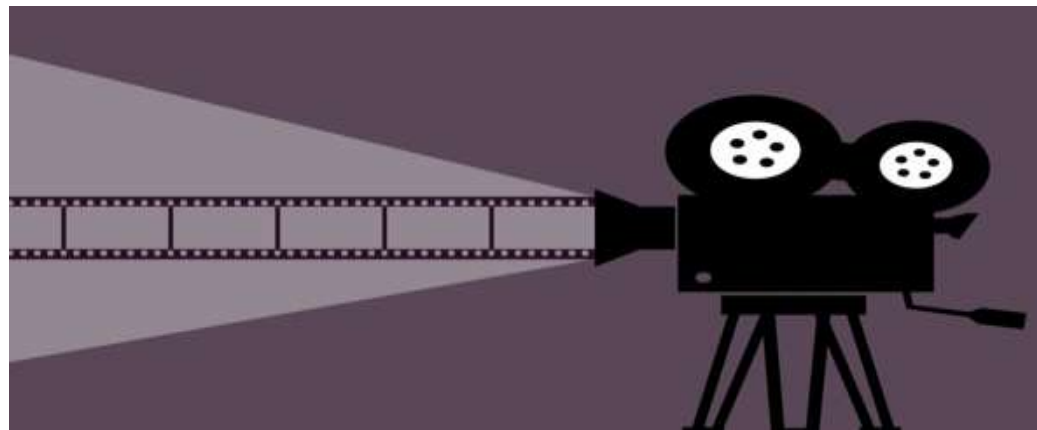


Town Committee in ADC

- The state Council of Ministers has decided to set up 'Town Committee' in ADC areas.
- In order to make 'Town Committee' "Tripura Tribal Areas Autonomous District (Establishment of Town Committee) Bill 2016 (TTAADC Bill – 01 of 2016) was passed in 2016 but it delayed come into effect due to some reasons.

Obituary

- The renowned Journalist **Jitendra Debbarma** passed away due to **COVID-19**.
- He was the **video Journalist** of Kokborok cable Television channel of Tripura



Police Commemoration Day

- The 'Police Commemoration Day' has been observed on 21st October 2020 with due dignity in the state along with the rest of the country.
- The main function was held at Arundhati Nagar Police line organised by the Home Department.
- The Chief Minister of Tripura Biplab Kumar Deb was present in the function as a chief guest. Moreover Chief Secretary Manoj Kumar, Chief Secretary of the Home Department Varun Kumar Sahu, Acting Director General of Police Rajiv Singh and other police officials were present on the occasion.

Meeting

- On 22nd October 2020, The newly appointed Assistant High Commissioner of Bangladesh to Tripura, Jubayed Hassan and the outgoing Assistant Kirti Chakma met with the Chief Minister of Tripura Biplab Kumar Deb at Secretariat.
- They discussed about various projects between two states India and Bangladesh Which will come into effect through Tripura.



One lakh to former militants

- On 22nd October 2020, The chief Minister of Tripura **Biplab Kumar Deb** handed over cheque worth **RS 1 lakh** each to the **136 former militants** during a programme.
- The programme was organised at **Rabindra Bhavan, Agartala**.



Nine National Highways project in Tripura

- On 27th October 2020, The Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari and the Chief Minister of Tripura Biplab Kumar Deb jointly laid the foundation stone of nine National Highways project in Tripura. This highways project cover 262 km and the total estimated cost of this project over RS 2,752 crore.
- These projects will provide faster and tension free inter-state and international connectivity to Bangladesh and it will boost Tourism sector of Tripura.

- The **nine National Highways project** are
 - 1) **National Highway 108A** from **Jolaibari to Belonia** (It covers **21.4 km** and the estimated cost of this project is **RS 201.99 Crore**).
 - 2) **National Highway 208** from **Kailashahar to Kumarghat** (It covers **18.60 km** and the estimated cost of this project is **RS 277.50 crore**).
 - 3) **National Highway 08** from **Khayerpur to Amtali** (It covers **12.90 km** and the estimated cost of this project is **RS 147 crore**).

Continue

- 4) **National Highway 108B** from **Agartala to Khowai** (It covers **38.80 km** and the estimated cost of this project is **RS 480.19 crore**).
- 5) **National Highway 208A** from **the Kailashahar to Kurti bridge**. (It covers **36.46 km** and the estimated cost of this project is **RS 473.49 crore**).
- 6) **National Highway 44A** from **Manu to Simlung** (It covers **36.54 km** and the estimated cost of this project is **RS. 595. 12 crore**).

- 7) RCC Bridge over river Muhuri and RCC Bridge over river Gomati . (The estimated cost of this project is RS. 83.06 crore).
- 8) Churaibari to Agartala (Section of National Highway 08). (It covers 74.85 km and the estimated cost of this project is RS. 257.96 crore).
- 9) Churaibari to Agartala (Section of National Highway 44). (It covers 27.789 km and the estimated cost of this project is RS. 236.18 crore).

13th State level Anthar Buthar Festival closing ceremony 2020

- The 13th State level Anthar Buthar Festival closing ceremony 2020 of the Malsom community was organized in the Bampai SB School ground in Killa under Gumati district on 27th October 2020.
- The Festival was celebrated with joint initiative of the Malsom Youth Association Dewan Chhara Cluster in Collaboration with ICA dept. govt of Tripura.
- Jeladipati of Gumati district Swapan Adhikari and Honorable MLA Ramapada Jamatia of Bagma Constituency and other reputed members were present in this festival.

Governor Rule extended in TTAADC area

- The Governor rule in Tripura Tribal Areas Autonomous District Council (TTAADC) area has been extended for another six months. The Governor of Tripura Ramesh Bais has extended the term of reemployment on contract basis of Balin Debbarma, IAS (retired) as Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of TTAADC and the former Tripura Chief Secretary and a retired IAS officer G.K Rao has been appointed as the administrator of TTAADC.
- The tenure of the current TTAADC came to an end on 17th May 2020. But owing to Coronavirus pandemic, conducting election in TTAADC was not possible.

Tripura's girl topped in Aligarh Muslim University

- Selina Akhtar from Uttar Maheshpur village under Kathalia block in Sonamura has created history by acquiring first position in the Aligarh Muslim University's (AMU) final year examination of Master of Arts in Economics 2020.
- Moreover she is the first girl from Tripura to have studied in the Aligarh Muslim University.
- The Aligarh Muslim University is a central University in Aligarh, Uttarpradesh. It was established by Sir Syed Ahmad Khan in 1875.

Continue

- First, This educational institution was formed as **Muhammedan Anglo-Oriental College** and in **1920** It was converted into **Aligarh Muslim University** under **Aligarh Muslim University Act**.

Mukhyamantri Unnat Godhan Yojana

- On 28 October 2020, The Chief Minister of Tripura **Biplab Kumar Deb** distributed certificates among beneficiaries under **Mukhyamantir Unnat Godhan Yojana**.
- It was organised by **Animal Resource Development Department** in **Agartala**.



“The e-ROR delivery system” of the Revenue Department/MOU between the Land Records and Settlement Department and the common Service Centre

- On 29th October 2020 “The e-ROR delivery system” of the Revenue Department of Tripura Government has been launched by Revenue Minister NC Debbarma through the Common Service Centre (CSC) to the public of the State.
- This new system will solve the issues related to land and its management and it also aimed at providing all land related information to the people through the common Service Centre (CSC).

Continue

- Moreover a **MOU** was signed between the **Land Records and Settlement Department** and the **Common Service Centre (CSC)** in the office room of the Revenue Minister of the Secretariat.
- **Revenue Minister NC Debbarma, Director of Land Records and Settlement Department Subal Debbarma, Head of Common Service Centre of Tripura Branch Biswajit Debnath, Revenue Secretary Tanushree Debbarma and Special Secretary of the Revenue Department Sharadindu Chowdhury** were present during the signing of MOU.

Tribal Welfare Department will be renamed

- On 29th October 2020, the Chief Minister of Tripura Biplab Kumar Deb has made an announcement that the Tribal Welfare Department will be renamed as “Indigenous (Janajati) Welfare Department.
- The Chief Minister made this announcement during his meeting with the leaders and eminent personalities of different indigenous communities on the occasion of Vijaya Dashami.
- Moreover the Chief Minister assured a proposal of RS 200 crore for development of road infrastructure in ADC areas sent to the centre for approval. Besides the State Government’s proposal for renaming Tripura Tribal Areas Autonomous District Council (TTAADC) to Tipra Territorial council will get centre’s nod very soon.

Continue

- Moreover **the issues** regarding Permanent **Settlement of around 34,000 Bru People** in Tripura was also discussed and the chief Minister also informed that **the Central Government** announced **RS 600 crore package** for **Bru People** rehabilitation.
- **Revenue Minister NC Debbarma, Forest Minister Mevar Kumar Jamatia, a special guest 101 Years old Pradmashree awardee Thanga Darlong, MP Rehati Tripura, MLA Ramapada Jamatia and MLA Atul Debbarma** were present in the meeting and shared their views.

Tripura ranked fifth in the Public Affairs Index (PAI) 2020

- Tripura has ranked fifth among the list of small states as the best governed states in the Public Affairs Index (PAI) 2020 report.
- The report was published by the Public Affairs Center on 31st October 2020.
- The Public Affairs Index 2020 is a scientifically rigorous data-based framework that measures the quality of governance at the Sub National Level. Ranks are given to States and Union Territories on a Composite Index. In this index States are classified into two categories, large states and small states using population at the criteria. The Index are made on the States's performance in sustainable Development Goals.

Continue

- Among the large States, **Kerala** has topped the rank and **Uttar Pradesh** was in bottom position.
- **Goa** has topped the index among the small states, while **Meghalaya** ranked Second position and **Himachal Pradesh** ranked the third position.
- Among the northeastern states, **Meghalaya** has topped the index . **Sikkim** in fourth place, **Tripura** has ranked fifth place (with 0.145) points, **Arunachal Pradesh** in Sixth place, **Mizoram** in Seventh place, **Nagaland** in eighth place and **Manipur** in eleventh place.

Continue

- From the North Eastern States, **Assam** has ranked **13th Place** in the index **among 16 large states** with **(0.0671)** points.

The State's first COVID 19 treatment Centre
