# Uttarpradesh

# Dudhwa National Park

- The Dudhwa National Park is located in Terai belt of marshy grassland of northern Uttarpradesh. The Park is situated near Indo-Nepal border, Lakhimpur Khetri district of Uttarpradesh. It covers an area of 490.3 Sq. km.
- The Park was established in 1958 and it converted into Tiger reserve in 1979.

# Valmiki National park

**Valmiki National park** is the only national Park in Bihar. It covers the area of **898.45 sq km**. It is also an Tiger reserve situated in **West Champaran district** of **Bihar**.

It was declared as Wildlife sanctuary in **1978** and in **1990**, it was established as **National park**. This is the **18<sup>th</sup> Tiger reserve** in the Country.

# Betla National Park

Betla National park is a national Park situated in Chota Nagpur Plateau in the Latehar and palamu district of Jharkhand. It covers an area of 1026 sq km.

palamu Tiger Reserve was a part of this National Park added in 1989. In 1974, The Tiger reserve has been implemented under the Project Tiger 1973.

# Hazaribagh National park

Hazaribagh National park is situated in Hazaribagh, Jharkhand.

The park was established in 1954.

# Indravati National park

**Indravati National park** is a national park which is situated in **Bijapur district of Chattisgarh**. Total coverage area of this park is **2799.08 sqkm**. The park derives its name from the name of **Indravati river**.

It was declared as **National Park** in **1981** and also it was declared as Tiger reserve site under **project Tiger in 1983**.

# Kanger Ghati National park

Kanger Ghati National Park also called Kanger Valley National park is situated in Jagdaipur in the Bastar region of Chattisgarh. It covers the area of 200 sq km. It is one of the densest national Park in India.

It was declared National park in 1982.

# Sanjay National park

Sanjay National Park also called Guru Ghasidas National Park is situated in Koriya district of Chattisgarh. It covers the total area of 180.177 sq km. Sanjay-Dubri Tiger reserve is a part of this park.

The park was established in 1983.
