Assam

Kaziranga National Park

Kaziranga National Park is situated in the Golaghat, Karbi Anglong and Nagon district of Assam. It covers the area of 430 sq km. This National park is famous for one-horned rhinoceroses. Two third of rhinoceroses are available in this park.

The park was established in 1904. It was added to UNESCO World Heritage site in 1985.

Orang National Park

Orang National Park or Rajib Gandhi Orang National park is situated in Northern part of Brahmaputra river Darrang and Sonitpur district of Assam. It covers the area of 79.28 sq km. Like Kaziranga It is also famous for one horned rhinoceros.

It was established as sanctuary in 1985 and finally it was declared as National park in 1999.

Nameri National park

Nameri National park is situated in foothill of Eastern Himalayas in the Sonitpur district of Assam. It covers the area of 200 sq km.

The park was established in 1978. This is the second Tiger reserve after Manas Tiger reserve (1999).

Manas National park

Manas National Park is situated in the foothill of Eastern Himalayas. It covers the area of 360 sq km.

The Park was established as sanctuary in 1928. The Park was added to UNESCO World Heritage site in 1985.

Dibru-Saikhowai National park

Dibru- Saikhowai National park is situated in Dibrugarh and Tinsukia district of Assam. It covers the area of 350 sq km.

The park was established in 1999.

Arunachal pradesh

Namdapha National Park

Namdapha National park is the fourth largest National Park in India and it is situated in Eastern Himalayas region of Arunachal Pradesh. It covers the total area of 1985 sq km.

The park was established in 1974.

Mouling National park

Mouling National park is situated in Siang district of Arunachal pradesh. It covers the area of 483 sq km.

The Park was established in 1986.

Meghalaya

Nokrek National Park

Nokrek National Park is situated in West Garo hills district of Meghalaya. It covers the area of 47.48 sq km.

The Park was established in 1986. In 2009 it was added to UNESCO list of Biosphere reserve.

Balpakram National Park

Balpakram National Park is situated in South Garo hills district of Meghalaya. It covers the area of 220 sq km.

The Park was established in 1987.

Manipur

Keibul Lamjao National park

Keibul Lamjao National Park is situated in Bishnupur district of Manipur. It is the only floating National Park in the world located in North East India in Loktak Lake. Total coverage area of this park is 40 sq km.

The Park was established in 1977.

Mizoram

Murlen National Park

Murlen National Park is situated in Champahai district of Mizoram. It covers the total area of 200 sq km.

The park was established in 1991.

Phawngpui National Park

Phawngpui National park is situated in Lawngtlai district of Mizoram, closely to Berma. The park was named after blue mountain of Mizoram 'Phawngpui' which is the highest mountain Peak of the state. It covers the total area of 50 sq km.

The Park was established in 1992.

Tripura

Clouded Leopard National Park

Clouded Leopard National Park is situated in Bishalgarh, Sepahijala district of Tripura. It is the part of Sepahijala wildlife sanctuary. Total coverage area of this park is 5.08 sq km.

The park was established in 2007.

Rajbari National park

Rajbari National Park is situated in Belonia, South district of Tripura. It is the part of Trishna wildlife sanctuary. It covers the total area of 31.63 sq km.

The park was established in 2007.

Sikkim

Kanchendzonga National park

Kanchendzonga National park is situated in North Sikkim. The park was named after the India's highest peak named Kanchenjunga (8586m). It is added to UNESCO World Heritage site in 2016. Total coverage area of this park is 849 sq km.

The Park was established in 1977.
