Kings of Tripura

- 1) Total no. of kings in Rajmala: **179.**
- 2) The previous name of Tripura: **Kirat Desh.**
- 3) First Capital of Tripura: **Dharmanagar.**
- 4) The first king of Tripura: **Druhya**
- 5) The father of Druhya: **Yajati.**

Manikya. (1468).

Old Haveli: 1761 during the reign of Krishna
