# Important Dates and Events of Tripura

**( 1948-1980 )**

# Important dates and events of Tripura

- 1) 1948: End of Council of Regency. Kanchan Prabha Devi was appointed as sole Regent. Tripura Gana Mukti Parishad was formed
- 2) 1949: Maharani Kanchanprabha Devi and C. Gopalachari, the Governor of General of India signed Tripura Merger Agreement. ( 9<sup>th</sup> September). Tripura is included in the Union of India. The Government of India takes over the administration of Tripura. Ranjit Kumar Roy was appointed as the first Chief Commissioner of Tripura . (15<sup>th</sup> October).
- 3) 1950: Tripura joined as 'C' category state in the union of India.

# Continue

- 4) 1951: First elections of Agartala Municipality were held. Sukhamay Sengupta became the first chairman of Municipality. ( 5<sup>th</sup> Nov).
- 5) 1952: 1<sup>st</sup> General Elections were held in Tripura ( 11<sup>th</sup> January). 30 members Electoral College was formed to elect one Rajya Sabha member. Md. Arman Ali Muni was elected the first Rajya Sabha member from Tripura.
- 6) 1953: Advisory Council was formed to advise Chief Commissioner by the President of India. Sachindralal Singha, Sukahmay Sengupta, Jitendramohan Debbarma became the members of the Advisory Council.

# Continue

- 7) 1956: Tripura was declared as Union Territory of India ( 1<sup>st</sup> November).
- 8) 1957: 2<sup>nd</sup> General Elections were held and Tripura Territorial Council with 30 members was formed.
- 9) 1959: Tripura Territorial Council started functioning and Sachindralal Singha became the chairman of Tripura Territorial Council.
- 10) 1963: Last Session of Tripura Territorial Council. Tripura Territorial council changed into Tripura Legislative Assembly. 5 member cabinet led by Chief Minister Sachindralal Singha was formed.

# Continue

- 11) 1964: The first rail service started in Tripura (Dharmanagar).
- 12) 1967: All India Radio started its service in Agartala.
- 13) 1970: Post of Chief Commissioner converted to Lieutenant Governor. Three districts were declared in Tripura. Agartala Museum was inaugurated by the first Lieutenant Governor A. L. Diyas.

# Continue

- 14) 1971: Presidents's rule was imposed in Tripura for the first time.
- 15) 1972: Tripura is declared 21<sup>st</sup> State of India under the act of North East areas (Reorganisation ). Braja Kumar Nehru was appointed as the first Governor of Tripura. Sukhmay Sengupta became the 2<sup>nd</sup> Chief Minister of Tripura.

# Continue

- 16) 1976: Tripura Board of Secondary Education was established.
  
- 17) 1977: First time in the history of Tripura Coalition Ministry of CFD –CPI(M) led by Prafulla Das was formed for 116 days. In the same year second Coalition ministry of Janata-CPI(M) led by Radhika Ranjan Gupta was formed for 102 days. President's rule was imposed for second time in Tripura.



# Continue

18) 1979: The law of Tripura Tribal Areas Autonomous District Council (TTAADC) under 5<sup>th</sup> Schedule was passed by the Tripura Legislative Assembly. Kokborok was declared as Official State language.
